Start with a phone call to your doctor's office or hospital.



ASK THEM FOR:

- A copy of your operative report
- A copy of your hip implant records

WE NEED THE PAGE OF YOUR RECORDS, USUALLY CALLED AN "IMPLANT RECORD" TO CONFIRM THE TYPE OF IMPLANT YOU RECEIVED.

Before you call, make sure you have the following ready:

- Date of surgery
- Your Social Security Number
- Your Date of Birth
- List of the records you need

Medical Records Forms:

You may have to fill out a form with your medical facility to request a copy of your records.

Medical Records Letter:

Sometimes you may have to write a letter to request your records. Make sure to include:

- Full name
- Address
- Date of birth
- Phone number
- Email
- List of records you need
